

INSTALL WI-FI MODULES TO PANEL

INSTRUCTIONS - SETTING UP WI-FI COMMUNICATION

1- The Honeywell Lynx touch unit comes with the Wi-Fi communication module installed if you purchased a complete system from Fox Guard, however if you purchased a Wi-Fi module as a separate upgrade then the below instructions will apply.

2- Open the Lynx Touch front panel by referencing the instructions in 2-2, power down the unit by unplugging the battery backup and removing the Honeywell transformer from the electrical outlet

3- Unpack the Wi-Fi module and carefully remove the electrostatic protective bag, saving the box and all manuals for future reference.

4- With the panel powered down, carefully plug the Wi-Fi module into the location under the speaker on the right side of the control board. The green PC board is the male connector itself and the Wi-Fi module contains the female connector.

5- Reconnect the battery backup and the transformer and allow the system to power up.

6- Green "Ready To Arm" will display when the unit is initialized. Press "Security" - Press "More" Press "Tools" enter the default code of 1-2-3-4 if the system is a new install. If this is your existing system enter your 4 digit keypad code instead.

7- Press "WiFi Config", Press "Scan Access Points", Press "Scan", Select your Wi-Fi network from the list shown. If your network is not shown, reference the troubleshooting section 11-1.

8- Select your network by touching the screen, then press "Edit", press "Key" and enter your Wi-Fi password for your network*

9- Press "Done", Press "Join". After these steps have been completed successfully the touchscreen will display "Successfully added to the Network" Press "OK" then press the green "Home" button below the touchscreen to return to the main screen.
